COMPATIBILITY AND INTENDED USE

MSW racks are compatible with bicycle frames that have threaded mounting points at the rear axle, and can accept bolts on mounts near the seatpost that are already integrated into the frame design, or can safely accept rubber-coated clamps around the frame. Carbon fiber frames are not compatible with MSW Racks. MSW Racks are intended for recreational riding, not aggressive or stunt riding.

The MSW Pork Chop Rack is compatible with most 700c cantilever and disc brake bicycles; check with your dealer.

▲ WARNING:

- . The maximum weight limit for the Pork Chop Rack is 40 lb
- This rack is only intended for use on the rear of a standard bicycle, do not use on any other vehicles
- . Do not modify the rack or attempt to use as a front rack
- Bicycle may behave differently (particularly steering and braking) when the rack is loaded
- Make sure to position reflectors and lamps securely so that they are not obscured when items are attached or loaded to the rack
- Make sure to evenly distribute loads on all sides of the rack
- · MSW racks are not designed to carry live cargo
- Only use the hardware included with your rack. Do not substitute with any other hardware

TOOLS AND SUPPLIES

Torque wrench that measures in Nm

4mm Allen wrench

8mm open-end wrench

INSTALLING THE RACK

Refer to technical drawings for appropriate hardware installation.

1. Loosely attach rack to lower rack mounts on bicycle using appropriate bolts and washers as shown in product diagram on page 1 (figure 1).

2. Loosely attach the rack struts to the rack (figure 2).

Loosely attach the rack struts to the threaded upper mounts on the bicycle or to rubber-coated clamps using two bolts and two washers (figure 3).

- 4. Extend rack struts until platform of rack is parallel to the ground.
- When the rack is level, tighten the bolts that secure the rack and struts directly to the bicycle frame, and all the hardware that attaches the struts to the rack to 4–5Nm.

ONGOING MAINTENANCE

Periodically check that all rack hardware and mounting bolts are properly torqued and secured to the bicycle frame. Periodically check for any loose fasteners or signs of cracking or failure and discontinue use if rack is damaged.



LIMITED 2-YEAR WARRANTY
