COMPATIBILITY AND INTENDED USE

The MSW Two-Leg Kickstand is intended to be installed on bikes used for riding on paved surfaces where the tires maintain contact with the ground.

The MSW Two-Leg Kickstand is designed to fit on frames with or without a kickstand plate, and on bikes with 700c or 26" wheels.

NOTE: For frames without a kickstand plate, please consult the frame manufacturer for compatibility. Installation of a kickstand on a frame that is not kickstand-compatible can damage the frame.

TOOLS

- · 8mm hex wrench
- 14mm open-end wrench
- Grease

INSTALLATION

- 1. Clean the frame or kickstand plate of dirt, grease, and other contaminants.
- 2. Lightly grease threads of fixing bolt.
- For frames with a kickstand plate: insert 8mm socket-head fixing bolt through split washer and kickstand plate of frame and thread into kickstand. Do not use top plate or 14mm hex-head fixing bolt.
- 4. For frames without kickstand plate: insert 14mm hex-head fixing bolt through split washer, top plate, between chainstays, and thread into kickstand. Position kickstand as close to the bottom bracket shell as possible without interfering with cables.
 - ▲ WARNING: Before fully tightening fixing bolt, ensure neither the kickstand, fixing bolt, nor top plate interfere with derailleur cables.
 - ▲ WARNING: Over tightening the kickstand on frames without a kickstand plate can damage the frame, rendering it unsafe to ride.
- Tighten fixing bolt until snug and kickstand can no longer move, or to the frame manufacturer's specification.

ONGOING MAINTENANCE

Periodically inspect your Two-Leg Kickstand to make sure the fixing bolt is tight and the kickstand cannot move.

WARRANTY REGISTRATION

Proof of purchase is required before a warranty claim is processed. MSW therefore strongly encourages warranty registration at mswbike.com. Failure to register will not affect consumer rights, so long as the consumer can show in a reasonable manner proof of original ownership and the date the MSW product was purchased.
